Commissioners' Report

April 2002

National Change of Address (NOCA)

One of the requirements from the 1995 National Voter Registration Act was the computer/manual check of each possible address change according to information supplied to us by the US Post Office. We are required each year to submit to the New York State Board of Elections a copy of our voter database, which is run against possible address changes reported to the US Post Office. We then receive a computer file of voters that have possibly moved.

With this file we run reports against the current voter files and manually check each possible address change. This year we checked 2,021 voter files and made changes to addresses. Of this number 503 updates were made to voters addresses. This is part of an ongoing, monthly effort on the part of the Oswego BOE to achieve the best possible address list to insure each registered voter is insured the right to vote.

Assembly-Senate Redistricting

With the passage of Chapters 35 and 38 of the Laws of 2002 the Assembly and Senate Districts were changed in Oswego County. The Board of Elections now has the task of resigning each of the 72,000+ voters to their new Assembly and Senate Districts. This task has been made much easier with the update to the Team 2000 Voter Registration, which can now update complete Towns and Cities to their new districts. Over the new few weeks we will be making these updates and double-checking the exceptions that are created from these movements.
