United States Department of Justice Suit Update

The New York State Board of Elections has submitted a draft compliance plan to respond to the Federal Department of Justice suit. It is worth noting that county boards will have the responsibility to implement the court "Plan B" in just a few short months including the selection, purchase, training (staff/inspectors/public), acceptance testing, delivery logistics, security and set up.

Ballot marking devises will be authorized by the NYSBOE on **May 17th** and county boards will have until **May 22nd** to place an order. The Office of Government Services has informed the State Board that it is imperative to the integrity of the bid process that all vendors be reviewed by county boards prior to any orders being placed.

The initial quantity of each county's orders will start to arrive no later than **June 30th** with acceptance testing by the state occurring within 72 hours.

The Oswego County Board has submitted a "Plan B" implementation plan that would place an accessible ballot marking devise in each of the 24 municipalities in the county.

March Village of Phoenix Elections Run Smoothly

The annual election in the second largest village in Oswego County creates a significant undertaking for the County Board. This "mini" Election must be fully prepared for, just as any full county Election, only on a smaller scale. Also, Board staff's hours was extended to cover the election for the normal Election Day questions and voter checks.
