



ELECTION COMMISSIONERS REPORT

Voter File Maintenance

Each year the County Board of Elections is required by state and federal law to send it's voter address file to the New York State Board of Elections. The file is checked against the National Change of Address file of the United States Post Office and returned to us.

From this information we must check each of these addresses and move them to their new correct address. This process takes several weeks in addition to our normal work and generates a mail notice to each person affected. This effort cuts down on our return rate of postage for our mail check of voters, which takes place in August each year.

Additionally, the Board once every month runs a maintenance program supplied by the New York State Board of Elections that removes deceased voters and those which have been convicted of a felony.

Board Reviews "Plan B" Voting Machine at NYSBOE Conference

The Commissioners reviewed several voting machines that the NYSBOE made available for Boards to decide which machine they will purchase by May 22nd.



In addition the Commissioners amended their original plan to the Department of Justice to be more closely aligned with the number of machines to be acquired by other counties thought-out New York State.
