



OSWEGO COUNTY DIRECTOR OF WEIGHTS AND MEASURES

This position is responsible for enforcing the provisions of Agriculture and Markets Law as it relates to weights and measures and protection of consumers. The Director has access to all places of business in order to determine the accuracy of scales, meters, rules and other measuring systems.

Qualifications: Completion of 24 semester college credit hours in the physical sciences, engineering sciences, electronic sciences, mechanical technology, or mathematics; **OR** two (2) years of work experience where the primary function included inspecting, testing, repairing or sealing measuring devices. **NOTE:** The minimum qualifications for this position are mandated under Section 179 (17) of New York State Agriculture and Market Laws. **SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:** This position requires extensive travel within the county. Possession of a valid New York State driver's license appropriate to the vehicles operated or otherwise demonstrate their ability to meet the transportation needs of the position.

A copy of your college transcript must be submitted with your application.

Permanent appointment to this position requires successful completion of the civil service examination.

Salary: \$43,497 - \$50,294 plus competitive benefit package including: health and life insurance, NYS Retirement and Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program.
