

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that the County of Oswego shall hold a Public Hearing relative to the **“OSWEGO COUNTY’S COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS AND PRIORITIES AND TO DISCUSS THE POSSIBLE SUBMISSION OF ONE OR MORE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) APPLICATIONS FOR THE 2018 PROGRAM YEAR”** on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2018, at 2:00 o’clock, in the afternoon of said day at the Oswego County Legislative Chambers, County Office Building, 46 E. Bridge Street, Oswego, NY 13126.

The CDBG program is administered by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR), and will make available to eligible local governments approximately \$45 million for the 2018 program year for housing, economic development, public facilities, public infrastructure, and planning activities, with the principal purpose of benefitting low/moderate income persons.

The hearing will provide further information about the CDBG program and will allow for citizen participation in the development of any proposed grant applications and/or to provide technical assistance to develop alternative proposals. Comments on the CDBG program or proposed project(s) will be received at this time. The hearing is being conducted pursuant to Section 570.486, Subpart I of the CFR and in compliance with the requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.

The location of this hearing is accessible to persons with disabilities.
